

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 88-1

Failure of Pay Fine/Appear, Individual Bond Posted, Appearance Not Required by Rule: In all traffic or conservation citations where a court appearance is not required pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 503 and 529, and where the defendant has executed an individual bond, if the defendant fails to appear in court, otherwise plead, or pay his fine and costs, the Clerk of the Court is directed to give the defendant 30 days notice and file herein a proof of service. If the defendant thereafter fails to pay his fine and costs, appear, answer or otherwise plead within 30 days after notice, a judgment in the amount of bond shall be entered and confirmed against the defendant for the amount of said bond.
