RULE 1.5 COURT PERSONNEL -AMENDED


(a) Court Complement. A full court complement consists of the judge, courtroom clerk, and sheriff or bailiff when court is in session. A full complement shall be maintained at all times unless waived by the court for good cause.

(b) Courtroom Clerk. The courtroom clerk shall be the Circuit Clerk or a Deputy Circuit Clerk or a Court Clerk, as designated by the Presiding Judge ~~authorized to swear witnesses~~. The courtroom clerk shall obtain all necessary files and record sheets for cases to be heard that day, may swear witnesses if authorized to do so, may maintain custody of all exhibits which have been marked for identification until further order of court, and perform such other duties as may be directed by the court.

(c) Sheriff – Bailiff. The sheriff or bailiff shall open and close court, preserve order in the courtroom, attend upon the jury when placed in his custody, and perform such other duties as may be directed by the court.
